<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Reading Books</u></b></p> <p>Reading books will be changed WEEKLY. Your child will get 2 new guided reading books when they return their previous ones. Please ensure books are in school <b><u>every day</u></b>.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>We are reading</u></b></p> <p>Take a picture of yourself reading a book for our class ‘we are reading’ display. Can you tell your teacher why you enjoyed the book? What was the best part?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Bookmarks- Year 1 words</u></b></p> <p>These are the words that we would like your child to be able to read and spell, as an age related expectation, by the end of Year 1.</p> <p>Your child will get a new tricky word bookmark when we move onto the next phonics stage.</p> <p>Please continue to practice reading or spelling the words on your bookmark.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Number</u></b></p> <p>Please help your child to work towards achieving this statement:</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>I can read and write numbers 1-20 as a number.</u></b></p> <p>Make your own number cards being carefully to write all your numbers correctly. Then can you practise your counting and order your cards? Can you sort your cards into odd and even numbers?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Topic Geography</u></b></p> <p>This half term we are learning about our local area and recycling. Can you use household recycling to create an art project based on the local area?</p> <p>This could be a model of your house, a map of your route to school or a model of the park. Be as creative as you like, just remember to use recycling to make your project. Please upload photos onto Seesaw.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Physical</u></b></p> <p><b>This half term we are focusing on key skills.</b></p> <p>See ‘We are Moving’ grid and upload evidence onto Seesaw. For each activity you complete you will receive a ‘We are Moving’ ticket for the prize draw at the end of this half term.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>RE</u></b></p> <p>This half term we are learning about being thankful at Harvest time. Can you think about what you are thankful for in your life?</p> <p>Harvest takes place in the season of Autumn. Can you look for signs of Autumn around Buckshaw Village and bring what you find (eg conkers, acorns, and pinecones) into School.</p>
