<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Reading Books</u></b></p> <p>A <b>reading book</b> and a Home Reading Record will be sent home every <b>Friday</b> in the homework folder. Please read with your child, discuss the book with them and ensure they complete the written task which relates to the book. This needs to be returned to school by the following <b>Thursday</b>. Please record in their Reading Record when they have read to an adult.</p> <p>Your child also has a <b>library book</b> which we would encourage them to read independently for at least 10 minutes each day. These are changed weekly.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Spelling</u></b></p> <p>Spellings for this term are on the back of this grid.</p> <p>Each list should be practised and learned each week for a test in class on the following Friday. They must understand the definition of each word.</p> <p>Please encourage your child to keep them safe and learn them every week. They are also available on the School website, on Year 5's class page.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Times Tables</u></b></p> <p>Your child has their own individual login for the free Times Tables Rock Stars app. This can be downloaded as an app or accessed through a web browser. The times tables that your child needs to learn are already set for them to practise. Please encourage your child to use Times Tables Rock Stars regularly, e.g. at least 3 times a week. We will complete times tables assessments in class at the end of each half term and also monitor their progress using the app.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Topic</u></b></p> <p>This term we will be learning about World War II. DO you know if anyone in your family was a soldier in World War II? Did anyone in your family work at the ROF where Buckshaw Village was built? What can you find out about our local area during WWII? Find out as much as you can about them and record it either on a fact file poster or digitally using Powerpoint.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Physical</u></b></p> <p style="text-align: center;">We are moving activities <b>or</b> Daily exercise of your choice.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>RE</u></b></p> <p>Choose a Bible story which you enjoy and turn it into a cartoon strip. Present it in a format of your choice – you might choose to use your computing skills!</p>
