<p><u>Reading Books</u></p> <p>Reading books will be changed WEEKLY. Your child will get 2 new guided reading books when they return their previous ones. Please ensure books are in school every day.</p> <p>When reading: Read the before reading page together, talking about any new words and how the book links to your child's experience. Ask your child questions about the story after they have read it.</p>	<p><u>Spellings.</u></p> <p>We will be starting to learn spellings this half term, to support the children with applying their phonics. These will be tested with a weekly spelling test each Friday. Please see the grid on the back for the weekly spellings.</p>	<p><u>Number</u></p> <p>Please help your child to work towards achieving this statement: I can recognise and use language relating to dates Including *days of the week *months *years *short date -dd/mm/yyyy EG: 12/04/2022 = 12th April 2022</p>
<p><u>Topic</u></p> <p>We are looking at Royal Life this half term as our topic. Can you research someone from the royal family (past or present) and create a fact file about them? In school we will be looking at: King Henry VIII, Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II.</p>	<p><u>Physical</u></p> <p>Try and complete at least 5 of the 'we are moving' challenges. Remember for each of the challenges you complete, you will get a 'we are moving' ticket to be entered into the prize box. When you have completed a challenge, take a photo or video and upload it onto seesaw so we can see you having lots of fun keeping fit and can give you your ticket.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>We are looking at the Easter story this half term and the miracle of how Jesus died and then rose from the dead for us. Can you create something to show how amazing the story is? It could be a: picture, poem, story, painting, model, song, comic, storyboard. The only limit is your imagination!</p>
