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DT Allergy letter

Dear Parent/ Guardian

As part of our DT curriculum, next week your child will have the opportunity to smell a range of spices (garam masala, fenugreek, paprika, turmeric & chilli powder) and taste a range of Indian Cuisine including: Mango Chutney, Curry sauce (made from: chopped tomato, onions, garlic & ginger paste, garam Masala, turmeric, chilli powder) & naan bread.

The children will then create their own curry paste using: onions, garlic and ginger paste, garam masala and 2 other spices (fenugreek, paprika, turmeric and chilli powder) of their choosing, before tasting mixed in with chopped tomatoes for evaluation purpose.

Please can you make sure the school are up to date and aware of any food allergies your child has. The packaging for the spices informs that, whilst not containing, they are 'packed in an environment that handles gluten, wheat flour, peanuts, other nuts, pepper, sesame, mustard, soya and milk powder.' and the mango chutney 'may contain peanuts, or other nuts'. We will be buying the naan breads this weekend and will ensure that all allergies are adhered to.
