Our Governing Body agreed in the summer term that we should increase our school meals price from £2.30 to £2.35, following an analysis of the costs of providing meals at KS2 . This increase will come into effect from Monday 1st November , 2021. The Autumn Winter Menu will be served from this date and can be viewed on the app.

As you know we have seen an increase in children testing positive for Covid in the last week or so and I am very grateful to those of you who have ensured children are tested when they have symptoms and have responded well to our requests for testing to keep the school community safe. If your child has any Covid symptoms on Tuesday 2nd November, please do not bring them into school and please organise a PCR test. If your child is sent home from school with symptoms they will need to have a negative PCR test, please, before they return to school.

We had hoped after half term to return to holding worship together in the hall and for parents to be invited in to Rewards Worship. I am sorry that we have taken the decision not to implement this change because of Covid concerns and will revisit this decision for January 2022.
