#### Headteacher's Message

Very good wishes to all of you for a 2022 filled with hope and happiness !

Thank you to all those parents who sent good wishes, cards or gifts into school at Christmas they were very greatly appreciated by all the staff.

I am pleased that we have been able to start the term positively with all of our classes open and the vast majority of staff in school. This situation is certainly not one that I take for granted, but I would like to reassure you that we will be doing all we can in any tricky times to come to maintain face to face learning as far as possible. As we found before Christmas when we had to close one of our year 1 classes there does however come a point where the safety of children is compromised by reductions in staffing levels and I will always seek to act in the best interests of the children backed by our Governing Body.

**If your child is due to start school in September, 2022 , please ensure that you have made your application online at Lancashire County Council's website before Saturday 15th January, 2022.**

**Please also remind any families you know with children of this age that this is the deadline for all primary schools.**

#### Updated Guidance from the DfE states .

##### Self-isolation:

Individuals who have tested positive for coronavirus are now able to end self-isolation after 7 days instead of 10 days **if they have negative LFD test results on days 6 and 7**. This applies to all people regardless of their age or vaccination status. The two LFD tests need to be taken 24 hours apart and the first test should not be taken before the sixth day. Pupils should only end their self-isolation period before 10 days if both LFD tests are negative and they do not have a high temperature. If the conditions for ending self- isolation early are met, pupils may return to school from day 7. Anyone who is unable to take lateral flow tests will need to complete the full 10-day period of self-isolation.

Thank you so very much for all of your support in keeping the school community as safe as possible . Please do keep up to date with changes to government guidance and we will continue to do our part in keeping everyone safe.
