School Meals

The Governing Body has made the difficult decision that our Key Stage 2 school meals price will need to increase in September from £2.40 to £2.50. It was a difficult decision as we want as many children as possible to benefit from school meals but increased food costs, energy costs and staffing costs were such that the school budget cannot sustain the increased costs. We hope that the increase coming in September, rather than straight away, will help you to plan. Even at £2.50, our school meals do provide excellent value for money.

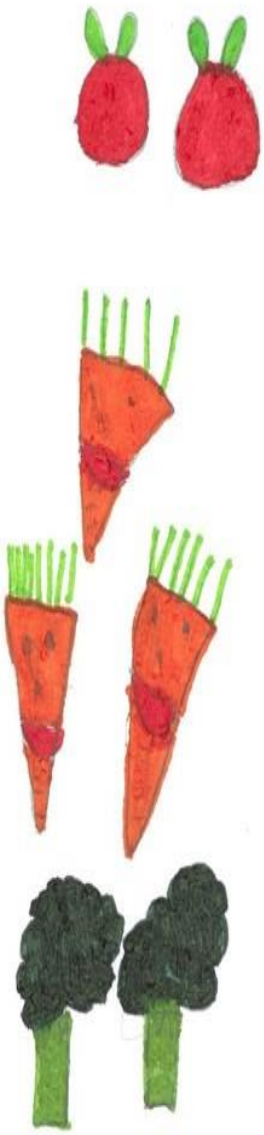

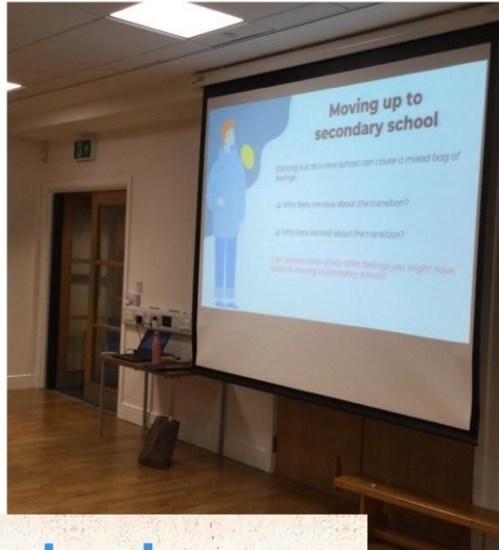
