#### Headteacher's Message

**I do hope the wonderful weather over the half term holiday has lifted your spirits. It was brilliant to see children sprinting across the playground on Tuesday excited to be back at Trinity!**

In this last part of the school year we are continuing to work in a Covid secure way and this has implications for some of the events that would normally happen at this time of year. We still cannot have large gatherings and children remain in their bubbles. As you can see from the list of events staff are doing all they can to ensure children really do enjoy this half term and that special moments are marked appropriately.

**One event which is not mentioned in the dates for your diary is Sports Day. We will not be having our traditional Sports Days and I am sorry that parents will not be invited. Each class will be organising their own event on the school field with children taking part in a number of sporting activities appropriate for their age group and having lots of fun. Stickers and certificates will be in abundance!**

We are trialling having worship in the hall for a year group at a time. This will be Covid safe as the hall is big enough to accommodate 90 children at safe distances and will help some of our children learn normal school routines as well as being fantastic to praise God together.
