Have a look in the Computing Suite at Unity Place to see some of the pictures from these visits.

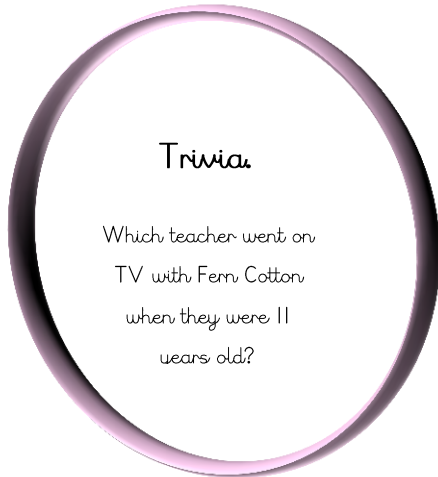

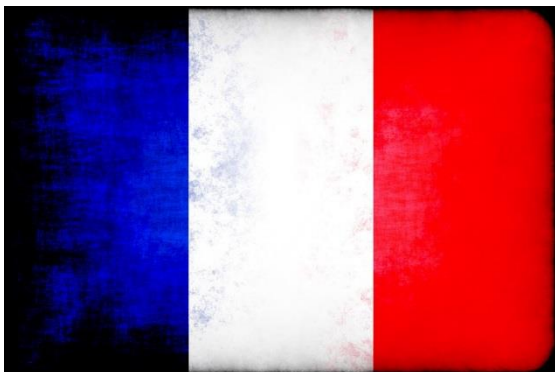
