<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Reading Books</u></p> <p>Please read daily for 20 minutes with your child. This could be their library book, books from home or their home reader. Home readers will be sent out every Thursday, please ensure they are returned to school the following week to be changed.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Please see the spelling list on the next page.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Times Tables</u></p> <p>Please use Times Tables Rockstars to practise your times table knowledge weekly. Children should know 2, 5 and 10x from Year 2 and must learn 3, 4 and 8x by the end of the year. Numbots is great for practising number bonds and mental addition/subtraction too.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Topic</u></p> <p>This term we are starting our Roman topic. Your child may want to complete additional research of what they have learnt in school. They could create a PowerPoint, poster or fact file on what they have found and this can be posted on Seesaw so their knowledge can be shared with their classmates.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Create your own Roman tile mosaics.</p> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around;"></div>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical</u></p> <p>Practice your fundamental skills for example, running, hopping, jumping, skipping. In an outdoor space you could create an obstacle course to practice these skills.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE</u></p> <p>What is the role of a faith leader who has been called by God?</p> <p>This half term we will be looking at the above question. The children will be exploring how people are called by God in their lives. Discuss with your children if you or any family member or friend has been called by God? How has this impacted their lives?</p> <p>If they would be willing to share any of their thoughts or stories regarding this, please write this down so it can be shared with the other children in class.</p>
