Dear Families, completing homework can help children consolidate many of the skills learnt in school. Please can your child complete ALL of the activities in the top row during the half term. Activities in the bottom row are optional but may be enjoyable for you all.

<h3><u>Reading Books</u></h3> <p>Read your reading books 3 times a week.</p> <p>Ask your children who, what, where, when and why questions as they are reading.</p> <p>Don't forget you can change your library book every week!</p>	<h3><u>Spelling</u></h3> <p>Practise your spellings 3 times a week.</p> <p>Can you write your word in bubbles in the bath? Can you write it with a stick in the soil? Can you 'write' it on someone else's back!</p> <p>Can you write it in rainbow colours? Can you write it in a sentence.</p> <p>Can you use the triangle method?</p> <p>As well as the spellings on the grid remember to practise your own Year 2 spellings.</p>	<h3><u>Times Tables</u></h3> <p>Go on Numbots or TTRS.</p> <p>Practise your number skills and see how many levels you can move up. Remember to answer quickly but correctly.</p> <p>Your log in details can be found in your yellow guided reading diary.</p>
<h3><u>Topic</u></h3> <p>In History we are learning about explorers and in English we are learning about space.</p> <p>Can you create a picture or model of space?</p> <p>You could draw, paint, build with recycling or even use your Lego to create your space art.</p>	<h3><u>Physical</u></h3> <p>Take a picture of you doing an exercise for every letter of your name.</p> <p>Eg- A aerobics, B bouncing, C catching.</p>	<h3><u>RE</u></h3> <p>We are learning about Jesus being a friend to everyone.</p> <p>Can you show that you are a good friend by performing a random act of kindness at home?</p>
