Reading

Please continue to read with your child at home, we will change reading books every Friday. The children take part in 2 reading practice sessions with a new book before bringing this book home on a Friday. Please use the ideas on the inside front and back covers to support your child.

Ask questions about the story as your child reads it, e.g. What is the story about? Why do you think they made that choice? Was it a good choice? Why did that happen? What do you think will happen next? What was your favourite part of the story? Why?

Please sign your child's reading diary, if your child reads 3 times at home they will be given a green reading ticket and entered into a draw, this takes place at the end of the half term.

Phonics

This half term we will be focusing on phase 4 phonics (Little Wandle). The grid below shows the sequence of teaching for this half term.

Please encourage your child to read and spell words containing the sounds we have learnt (see Little Wandle Grapheme Mat on Seesaw). In addition to this please focus on reading and spelling the tricky words in the grid above.

<u>Maths</u>

Number:

Practise counting beyond 20. What number can you count up to?

Ordering numbers 1-20. Can you order three numbers? For example if you have the following numbers - 9, 4, 17, 11 - can you put them in the correct sequence - 4, 9, 11, 17?

Can you correctly form numbers 1-20?

Calculation:

Roll two dice, how many spots are on each dice? How many spots are there altogether? Can you write the number? Can you write a sum using the numbers?

Collect 5 leaves from outside. Find 4 more. How many leaves do you have altogether?

Build a tower with 7 bricks. Take 3 bricks away. How many bricks are left? Share out 15 biscuits between 5 of your favourite toys. How many biscuits does each toy have? Is it fair?

<u>Measure</u>:

Find two or three sticks. Find out which stick is the longest/shortest.

Who is the tallest person in your family?

Go on a Spring hunt. Draw some of the signs of Spring that you can see. This half term we will be learning about minibeasts. Which minibeast is your favourite? Can you find out some information about it? Use some recyclable materials to make a minibeast. Take a photo of your model and put it on Seesaw.
