Previous reading books will be collected in a Monday.</p> <p>Your child will get a new reading book to read at home when they return their previous ones. They will also choose a library book to share at home.</p> <p>Please ensure books are in school <u>every day</u>.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>We Are Reading</u></p> <p>Take a picture of yourself reading a book for our class 'We are reading' display. Can you tell your teacher why you enjoyed the book? What was the best part?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Writing</u></p> <p>Our topic this half term is 'Penguins, Possums and Pigs'.</p> <p>Can you draw a picture of your favourite animal and write a sentence to tell your teacher all about you.</p> <p>Please use your finger spaces and full stops. Try to use your phonics to spell your words.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Number</u></p> <p>Please help your child to work towards achieving this statement: <u>I can read and write numbers 1-30 as a number.</u></p> <p>Make your own number cards being carefully to write all your numbers correctly. Then can you practise your counting and order your cards? Can you sort your cards into odd and even numbers?</p> <p>Challenge: Can you write some of these numbers in words?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Geography</u></p> <p>This half term we are learning about hot and cold places.</p> <p>Can you have a go at drawing the clothes you would wear for a hot and cold day?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical</u></p> <p>This half term we are focusing on key skills.</p> <p>See 'We are Moving' grid and upload evidence onto Seesaw. For each activity you complete you will receive a 'We are Moving' ticket for the prize draw at the end of this half term.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>RE</u></p> <p>This half term we are learning about being thankful at Harvest time. Can you think about what you are thankful for in your life?</p> <p>Harvest takes place in the season of Autumn. Can you look for signs of Autumn around Buckshaw Village and bring what you find (eg conkers, acorns, and pinecones) into school?</p>
