The log in details for this is in your child's yellow reading record.</p>
<p><u>Topic</u></p> <p>In science this half term, we are looking at different materials.</p> <p>Can you complete a science experiment to see which material a toy car can travel the fastest on? A plastic lid or a wooden table are just 2 examples you could use for your science experiment.</p>	<p><u>Creative</u></p> <p>In Geography this half term we are learning about our local area and looking at familiar maps.</p> <p>Please draw a detailed picture of your house and the street you live on. Can you find your house or street on a map? Can you follow the map to school. Which roads do you travel on? What do you pass each day when walking to school?</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>In RE we are learning about birth rites, baptism and the idea of belonging.</p> <p>Can you draw a picture or upload a photo of group that you belong to?</p> <p>For example, your class, school, church, friends, rainbows or maybe a sports club? Write a sentence about the group that you belong to.</p>
<p><u>Our learning this half term:</u></p>		
<p><u>English</u></p> <p>In English this half term we will be using joining words to link sentences together. We will be introducing what a verb is and how we can change the word by adding 'ing'. E.g cook becomes cooking. We will also be writing our own stories that follow a familiar plot.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>In maths this half term we will be learning to tell the time to the hour, draw hands on the clock to show times to the hour and tell the time to the half hour. We will also be looking at place value and fractions.</p>
