Dear Families,

Welcome to Year 4. Completing homework can help children consolidate many of the skills learnt in school. Please can your child complete ALL of the activities in the top row during the half term. Activities in the bottom row are optional but may be enjoyable for you all. Completed activities can be brought into school to be displayed in our homework area. All photos and videos can be uploaded onto Seesaw.

<u>Reading Books</u> A reading book and a Home Reading Record will be sent home every week. Please read with your child, discuss the book with them and ensure they answer a few questions which relate to the book. Please sign the yellow book and add any comments to confirm that they have read aloud. There some sample questions and ideas for discussion topics at the front of their yellow book. Your child also has a library book which we would encourage them to read independently for at least 10 minutes each day.	<u>Spelling</u> Spellings for this term are on the back of this grid. We will be learning them in class spelling lessons each week. Each list should also be practised and learned at home each week for a test in class on a Friday. Please encourage your child to learn them every week. They will be available on Seesaw and on the school website.	<u>Times Tables</u> Your child has their own individual login for the free Times Tables Rock Stars app. This can be downloaded as an app or accessed through a web browser. Please encourage your child to use Times Tables Rock Stars regularly, e.g. at least 3 times a week. We will complete times table assessments in class regularly and also monitor their progress using the app. Please ask them to use the Garage area to help them to learn the spellings and the sound check if they want to challenge themselves up to 12 x 12. https://ttrockstars.com/login
<u>Topic</u> In geography we are learning all about taking care of our environment. We will be learning about what is meant by recycle, reduce and reuse. Have a walk in your local area. Take some pictures or draw a picture of the environment that you live in and write about why you like it. Is there anything that you don't like? How could it be improved?	<u>RE</u> In RE we are learning about inspirational people like Nelson Mandela. In the Bible, we are learning that King David was an inspiration to his people. Draw a picture and write about a person who inspires you. Talk about their qualities and why you are inspired to be like them.	<u>DT</u> In DT we are learning about lights and will be making our own using electrical components. Why not try to make your own Lava lamp? They are easy to make and fun to look at. There are simple instructions on Seesaw or you can use your skills and imagination to make something even more imaginative.
