You may have seen that the Government are launching a push to improve school attendance. We had absolutely superb attendance on our first day back and I do hope that this can continue for the whole term . You can see that there is lots of inspiring learning ahead for our children this half term and we wouldn't want anyone missing out !

Parents who are considering Reception school places for their children for September 2024 need to submit their applications via the LCC website by Monday 15th January 2024, please.

As we start the term we are asking please will you ensure your child is following our uniform expectations, especially for footwear, hairstyles and jewellery so that we all are smart and ready to learn:

Purple sweatshirt/cardigan with embroidered gold school logo

White polo shirt

Grey trousers/shorts , Grey skirt/pinafore dresses (not culottes)

Purple checked summer dress

White socks/grey tights with skirts, Black or grey socks plain with trousers

Black shoes only with black soles (no boots)

PE kit: Black shorts, Purple polo shirt with school logo

Black Trainers (preferably non branded) with non-marking soles

Draw string PE bag (available with school logo or own choice draw string bag)

Children may wear dark coloured joggers and jumper (no logo) and trainers (Outdoors)

(Trainers are not part of school uniform and are not to be worn during the normal school day)

Swimming:Swimming costume (not bikini)/trunks (not shorts)

(Year 5) Swim hat

Towel

Coats: Coats with the Trinity logo are available for purchase

Or children may wear coats of their own choice

Bags :Reading bags with the Trinity logo

(Large bags, back packs and pencil cases are not permitted in school)

Jewellery: Stud earrings may be worn but must be removed for PE and swimming.

Watches may be worn. Smart watches are not permitted.

Nail varnish / false nails are not permitted.

Please note if ears have just been pierced and earrings cannot be removed please cover the earrings with tape or provide plasters for your child to put over them for PE

Hair: School will not tolerate outlandish and extravagant hairstyles (eg tramlines), or styles following the extremes of fashion or modes of dress. Any hair accessories should be minimal, plain and reflect the colour of the school uniform.
