ATTENDANCE UPDATE

From September 2025, new legislation states that there needs to be changes to the way fines are issued, relating to attendance. The <u>three</u> <u>year</u> rolling period for attendance will start in September 2025.

If your child has more than <u>10 sessions (5 days)</u> of unauthorised absence within a rolling <u>10 school</u> <u>week period</u>, it will trigger a penalty notice. The absences could include arriving late after the register closes.

On the first time the penalty notice will be a $\underline{\$160}$ fine, for each parent and for each child that has been absent.

If it is paid in 21 days it can be reduced to £80.

On the second time a penalty notice is triggered within a 3 year rolling period, there will be a fine of £160 for each parent and each child that has been absent.

It cannot be discounted.

There is a maximum of two penalty notices that can be issued within a 3 year period. On the third offense another course of action will be considered, e.g. prosection or another legal intervention.
